GRAPE VARIETY

Chardonnay, the emblematic variety of great white Bourgogne wines.

VINES

"Champ Cardin" is located in the village of Culles-les-Roches, stretches across a thatched plateau at an altitude of 400 m. Facing east, the Chardonnay vines (3.20 hectares) are planted the limestone soil, which is thin, very dry and permeable. That give this cuvée its distinctive minerality. So many characteristics that make this a unique wine.

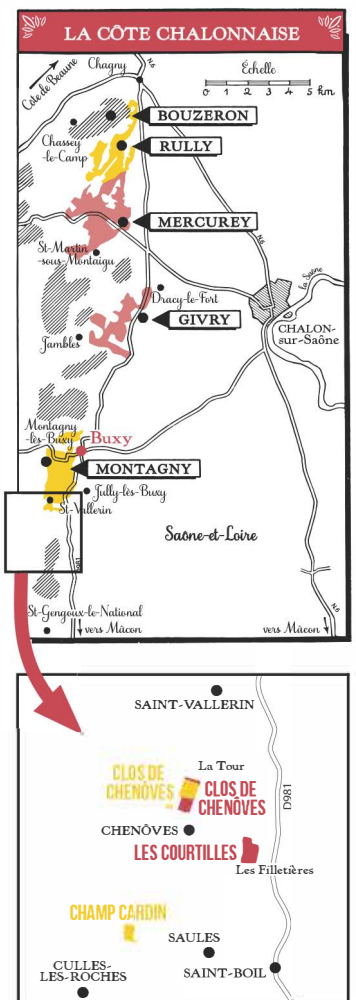
WINEMAKING AND MATURING

Grapes harvested when perfectly ripe. Pneumatic pressing to preserve the quality of the juice. Careful settling to bring out the expression and authenticity of the terroir. Fermentation (alcoholic, malolactic) and ageing on fine lees in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats to reveal the wine's aromatic brilliance and give it a certain roundness. The wine is bottled at the optimum time and left to rest before being marketed.

TASTING NOTES

This pale gold-coloured wine reveals a frank nose of lime blossom. Tonic and elegant on the palate, with a beautifully pure chalky finish. A gourmet expression of Chardonnay.

Serving temperature: 11 to 13°C
